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### WHOLE STAFF TEAM MODULE 3 HOURS

#### Who is this for?

This module is for whole Education staff teams, including the SLT, Governors, teaching and support staff.

#### Learning Aims

- The impact of Covid-19 on all pupils with a special focus on trauma, loss and transition
- The additional impact of Covid-19 on vulnerable pupils, particularly those with earlier trauma and attachment disruptions
- Principles of engagement – how all staff can relate to pupils in a way which enables them to engage with learning and relationships.
- Practical strategies – what all staff can do to support pupils transition back into the school environment, and begin to thrive again
- The module will also include a range of bespoke resources

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### **LEADERSHIP MODULE 2 HOURS**

#### **Who is this for?**

This module is for Head Teachers, Assistant Heads, Governors and other senior leaders who have a role in designing and implementing whole-school responses to the needs of staff, pupils and parents/carers.

#### **Learning Aims**

- To understand the impact of Covid-19 on staff well-being
- To understand the principles of a trauma-informed approach to responding to the needs of staff and to pupils
- To anticipate psychological risks and difficulties in pupils and staff, including the delayed impact of Covid-19
- To consider policies and procedures which will buffer the potential risks to learning, emotions, behaviour and community
- To reflect on how to include parents/carers in the school's Covid-19 response

#### **Optional remote Q&A consultation**

An optional remote consultation with a Clinical Psychologist or a Specialist Educational Psychologist in the Beacon House Team is available for those who completed the above leadership module.

#### **The aims of the consultation include:**

- To ask further questions about the content of the training module
